● Intended use

- This product is intended for drying and styling human hair.
- The product must not be used on artificial or animal hair. Do not use the product for any other purpose.
- The product is only intended for use in private households. The product is not suitable for commercial purposes.
- The manufacturer accepts no liability for damages caused by improper use.

● Scope of delivery

After unpacking the product, check if the delivery is complete and if all parts are in good condition. Remove all packing materials before use.

⚠ CAUTION! Risk of burns! Keep the product out of reach from young children, particularly during use and cool down.

- When the product is connected to the mains supply: Never leave the product unattended.

- When the product is heating up or cooling down: Never place the product on a table and close to other objects.
- When the product is used in a bathroom: Remove the mains plug from the mains outlet after use. The proximity of water presents a hazard, even when the product is switched off.
- For additional protection: The installation of a residual current device (RCD) having a rated residual operating current not exceeding 30 mA is advisable in the electrical circuit supplying the bathroom. Ask your installer for advice.

- Clean all parts of the product as described (see "Cleaning").
- Before connecting the product to the mains outlet: Check that the voltage corresponds with the mains supply details shown on the product's rating label.
- Do not use the product outdoors.
- Do not operate the product with wet hands or while standing on a wet floor.
- Do not touch the mains plug with wet hands.
- Do not pull the mains plug out of the mains outlet by the mains cord.
- After use and before cleaning: Disconnect the product from the mains supply. The product is completely free of electrical power only when unplugged.
- Do not kink or crush the mains cord, and route the mains cord

so that it cannot be stepped on or tripped over.

- Protect the product, the mains cord and the mains plug against heat, dust, direct sunlight, dripping and splashing water.
- Do not use or store the product in or expose it to a humid environment.
- Always place the product on a heat-resistant, stable, flat surface.

● **First set-up of the product**

● **Unpacking the product and basic cleaning**

① **INFO:** The product may give off some odour during first use. This is due to production or transport residues that will quickly subside. Ensure sufficient ventilation in the area.

1. Take the product out of the packaging and remove all packaging materials.
2. Check to make sure that all listed parts are included (see "Scope of delivery").
3. Check whether the product and all parts are in good condition, if any damage or defect is detected, do not use the product, but follow the procedure described in chapter "Warranty".

● **Operation**

● **Off mode**

- The product enters off mode automatically when:
 - the product is connected to the mains supply and
 - the function switch **4** is in **0** position
- When the product is not in use: Remove the mains plug **8** from the mains supply.

● Drying and styling hair

⚠ CAUTION! Risk of burns! The product becomes very hot during use.

- When the product is switched on or cooling down: Never touch the brush attachment with air outlet [2].
 - Always hold the product by its handle [5].
 - Never place the switched on or hot product on a table.
 - Never block the air inlet [6] or the air outlet [2].
 - If any hair gets caught in the brush attachment [2]: Switch off the product. Remove the hair carefully after the product has cooled down.
1. Connect the mains plug [8] to a suitable mains outlet.
 2. Slide the function switch [4] into the suitable position:

Function switch	Function mode
0	Product switched off
1	Product switched on: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Low heat and speed ■ Ideal for sensitive or fine hair
2	Product switched on: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ High heat and speed ■ Ideal for normal hair

3. Grasp an approximately 4 cm wide strand of hair and hold it at the brush attachment [2]. If necessary, hold the cap [1] briefly to rotate the product (Fig. C).
4. Guide the product evenly along the strand from close to the root to the tip. Place the brush attachment [2] at the end of hair, then rotate the appliance by the handle to roll the hair onto the brush attachment [2]. Do not hold the product too long on any part of the hair strand.

5. Releasing hair from the brush attachment [2]: Slide the curl release button [3] towards the handle [5] and hold it in position. Pull the product down simultaneously. The brush attachment rolls out of the lock (Fig. D).
6. Repeat the steps 3. to 5. until the result is satisfactory.
7. Work through the strands section by section until all hair is styled as desired.
8. After use: Slide the function switch [4] to position **0** to switch off the product. The product enters off mode.
9. Disconnect the mains plug [8] from the mains outlet.
10. Allow the product to cool down completely.

● Styling tips

- Use the product to style small curls and waves and to dry slightly damp hair.
- Preventing heat damage: Avoid brushing your hair for extended periods or maintaining prolonged contact with the product.
- A suitable styling product can enhance the durability of the curls. Choose a styling product that also contains heat protection.
- Before using the product:
 - Dry your hair until it is slightly damp. We do not recommend to style hair that is too wet.
 - Use a comb to thoroughly comb the dry hair.
- If you want to comb out the hair after styling: Allow the hair to cool down well first.

● Troubleshooting

Problem	Cause	Solution
The product is not working.	The mains plug 8 is not connected to a mains outlet.	Connect the mains plug 8 to a suitable mains outlet.
	The mains outlet is defective.	Connect the mains plug 8 to a different mains outlet.
The product is not sufficiently heated up.	The set temperature is too low.	Set a higher heat level (see "Drying and styling hair").

● Cleaning and care

⚠ **WARNING! Risk of electric shock!**

- Disconnect the mains plug **8** from the mains outlet.
- Do not immerse the product in water or other liquids.

⚠ **CAUTION! Risk of burns!**

Allow the product to cool down completely.

- ### ⚠ **NOTICE! Risk of product damage!** Do not use any aggressive cleaning liquids or solvents. These can damage the surface of the product.

● Removing/attaching the brush attachment

(Fig. B)

Removing the brush attachment

1. Turn the cap **1** in anticlockwise direction.
2. Remove the cap **1**.
3. Pull the brush attachment **2** off the product.

Attaching the brush attachment

1. Attach the brush attachment **2** to the product.
2. Fastening the cap **1**: Turn the cap in clockwise direction.

● Cleaning

Cleaning the product

1. Remove the brush attachment **2** from the product (see "Removing/attaching the brush attachment").

2. Wipe the product with a slightly damp cloth. For stubborn soiling, use a mild cleaning detergent.
3. Let the product dry completely.

Cleaning the brush attachment

1. Remove any remaining hair from the brush attachment **2**.
2. Remove the brush attachment **2** from the product (see "Removing/attaching the brush attachment").
3. Clean the brush attachment **2** with lukewarm water and a mild cleaning detergent.
4. Rinse the brush attachment **2** with clear water.
5. Let the brush attachment **2** dry completely.
6. Attach the brush attachment **2** to the product (see "Removing/attaching the brush attachment").

● Storage

- For short term storage: Use the hanging loop **7** to hang the product.
- Store the product in the original packaging.
- Store the product in a cool, dry place, protected from moisture and out of the reach of children.

● Disposal

The packaging is made entirely of recyclable materials, which you may dispose of at local recycling facilities.



Observe the marking of the packaging materials for waste separation, which

are marked with abbreviations (a) and numbers (b) with following meaning:
1-7: plastics/20-22: paper and fibreboard/80-98: composite materials.

The warranty for this product is 3 years from the date of purchase. The warranty period begins on the date of purchase. Keep the original sales receipt in a safe location as this document is required as proof of purchase.

Any damage or defects already present at the time of purchase must be reported without delay after unpacking the product.

Should the product show any fault in materials or manufacture within 3 years from the date of purchase, we will repair or replace it – at our choice – free of charge to you. The warranty period is not extended as a result of a claim being granted. This also applies to replaced and repaired parts.

This warranty becomes void if the product has been damaged, or used or maintained improperly.

The warranty covers material or manufacturing defects. This warranty does not cover product parts subject to normal wear and tear, thus considered consumables (e.g. batteries, rechargeable batteries, tubes, cartridges), nor damage to fragile parts, e.g. switches or glass parts.
